<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> A total of \$3,900,000 is anticipated from the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) for Project 90A011, Dulles Corridor Slip Ramps. To date, \$2,449,599 has been received and \$1,450,401 is anticipated in FY 2008.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> Represents anticipated Federal Transportation Administration (FTA) grant funding in the amount of \$1,176,725. FTA funding is based on reimbursements of approximately 75 percent of expenditures which may fluctuate based on actual project scopes. Total FTA reimbursements equal \$39,158,860 and include \$5,205,000 for Wiehle Avenue Commuter Parking, \$25,661,845 for the Herndon/Monroe Transit Center, \$4,225,807 for Park and Ride facilities, and \$4,066,208 for several Dulles Corridor projects.

Therefore, funding for capital projects is carried forward each fiscal year, and ending balances fluctuate, reflecting the carryover of these funds.
