¹ Significant savings in sewer operations during FY 2010 have resulted in an increase to fund balance. DPWES staff have been asked to return to the Board of Supervisors in the fall of 2010 to review and evaluate fund balances and examine future rate requirements for sewer service charges and availability fees for the next several years.

² The Wastewater Management Program maintains fund balances at adequate levels relative to projected operation and maintenance expenses. These costs change annually; therefore, funding for sewer operations and maintenance is carried forward each fiscal year, and ending balances fluctuate, reflecting the carryover of these funds.
