Question: Identify sites and number of porta-johns at school athletic field sites.

Response: The following chart provides the most recent breakdown of porta-john facilities located at school sites managed by the Department of Community and Recreation Services. It should be noted that placement of these facilities changes somewhat from season to season as need dictates. Criteria for placement is primarily driven by the sites' volume of scheduled community use, as well as their potential as "hot spots" for walk-on use.
