- Supervisors touted benefits of Geographic Information Systems (GIS), including GIS Day.
- Director's enthusiasm complimented.
- Court room technology accomplishments lauded by Virginia Association of Counties.
- Discussion took place regarding centralized turning on and off of staff computers.
- Work Performed for Others was explained.
- Supervisor McKay Provide update on remote testimony possibilities.
- Agency has about 300 staff and Supervisor Gross asked how technological advancements have impacted hiring trends in terms of shifts from other agencies to DIT.
 - Staff explained that technology has enabled agencies to increase productivity and limit staff increases as requirements have increased
 - Increases may be needed in IT given exploding demands.

- Discussion took place regarding recruiting to address aging workforce and position turnover.
 - One strategy is cross training to increase knowledge more broadly among staff.
 - Recruiting earlier for positions where long time incumbents are retiring to provide maximum overlap.
 - Started academic rotation program to engage with younger potential staff.
 - Not as much trouble as past in recruiting physicians.
