Question: Please describe what the Health Department's environmental inspections entail.

Response:

The Health Department's Division of Environmental Health (DEH) enhances the Fairfax County community's quality of life by protecting public health and safeguarding environmental quality, educating the public to increase environmental awareness, and implementing and enforcing local and state laws. DEH regulates the following through review, permitting, inspection, and enforcement activities: retail food establishments; public water recreation facilities; small drinking water systems; onsite wastewater systems; lodging establishments (hotels/motels); tattoo/body art operations; temporary food establishments; and mobile food establishments (vehicles, trailers, pushcarts). In 2010 the Board of Supervisors transferred the enforcement of the property maintenance code to the Department of Code Compliance (DCC). As a result, DEH's role is limited to assisting DCC with property maintenance enforcement by offering community outreach and public education specific to pest management.

The Department of Code Compliance was created in 2010 as a unified code enforcement agency to address life-safety and community quality of life matters resulting in violations of the Zoning Ordinance; Virginia Maintenance Code; Building Code; certain residential aspects of the Fire Code; the State's provisions pertaining to Spot Blighted structures; and the County's grass ordinance. Additionally, certain provisions of the County's Chapter 46 pertaining to structural public nuisances were delegated by amendment in 2014 both to the Maintenance Official in DCC and the Building Official in Department of Public Works and Environmental Services.

The provisions under DCC's authority that most directly pertain to pest infestation are found in the Virginia Maintenance Code, which is Part III of the Virginia Statewide Building Code. It specifically addresses insect and rodent infestations that are adversely affecting a structure. Among a host of problems that can arise from this damage, of particular concerns are structural damage to load-bearing walls and supports, loss of weather-proofing and heating efficiency, and the potential for fire resulting from rodents eating electrical insulation. Such pests that can typically cause such damage include, but are not necessarily limited to, mice, rats, certain woodeating ants, and termites. Insects such as mosquitoes, bed bugs, cockroaches, and others that do not cause structural or building damage (despite their impact on quality of life) are not addressed in the Virginia Maintenance Code and consequently DCC has no authority over such infestations.

Question: What is the strategy to add more beds for those experiencing domestic violence?

Response:

In Fairfax County the demand for 24-hour emergency shelter for victims of domestic violence remains high, but the County lingers behind national standards for an adequate number of domestic violence shelter beds. The County's 24-hour domestic violence shelter, Artemis House, currently has 42 beds, which equates to only one bed for every 27,000 residents in the County. This compares to the national standard of one bed for every 14,000 residents, which would require approximately 80 beds for a community of this size. It should be noted that the current capacity is a combination of both County funded and grant funded beds.

Currently Artemis House is located in an area that has been identified for revitalization and mixed-use development. The current leased space is planned for demolition as part of the redevelopment and as a result, Artemis House will need to be relocated. Over the past five years, the Office for Women and Domestic and Sexual Violence Services (OFWDSVS) has focused efforts on identifying a more central location for Artemis House and securing increased bed space for victims of domestic and sexual violence, stalking, and human trafficking. The department has investigated repurposing group homes, purchasing units, and utilizing County and Housing and Community Development (HCD) housing units. However, each of these attempts was unsuccessful due to a variety of barriers and issues. OFWDSVS is continuing to work with HCD and the Department of Planning and Zoning (DPZ) to identify strategies to mitigate the barriers.

In the short term, because the current location has been identified for redevelopment, OFWDSVS is partnering with HCD to temporarily move Artemis House to another location in North County; however, the number of beds will remain the same. OFWDSVS and HCD are pursuing a longer-term strategy to permanently relocate Artemis House to the central part of the County with the intent to increase capacity to 84 beds, which exceeds the national standard, but takes into account future population growth and increased need. Several possibilities are being explored including the purchase of a new property, repurposing an existing property, or the co-location of shelter beds with other County services as part of new construction.

Question: Compare the County's living wage to the wages paid by contractors providing

custodial services.

Response:

Fairfax County procures custodial services through competitive negotiations as provided in the Virginia Public Procurement Act (VPPA) and the Fairfax County Purchasing Resolution. The purpose of the VPPA "is to enunciate the public policies pertaining to governmental procurement from nongovernmental sources." In 2006, the Virginia Attorney General was asked to provide an opinion on whether a locality may stipulate a minimum or living wage requirement that must be paid by private contractors and vendors to their employees. The concept of a living wage is a matter of social, political and economic policy that is not related to the goods or services sought to be procured. Accordingly, the Virginia Attorney General advised that the locality does not have the authority to require a minimum or living wage be paid to contractors without explicit authority from the General Assembly.

The Living Wage adopted by the Board of Supervisors in September 2008 is equal to \$13.13 per hour. Current Fairfax County custodial contractors are members of a part-time workforce. In addition, the contractors categorize the custodial employees' wages as direct labor that is compensated using a range of hourly rates noted in the table below:
