## ADMINISTRATIVE

### Authorization to Advertise a Public Hearing to Amend the Current Appropriation Level in the FY 2017 Revised Budget Plan

#### ISSUE:

Board approval of an advertisement for a public hearing to adjust the FY 2017 appropriation level. The advertisement encompasses both the County and the Schools' *FY 2017 Third Quarter Reviews*. Section 15.2-2507 of the Code of Virginia requires that a public hearing be held prior to Board action to amend the current appropriation level.

#### RECOMMENDATION:

The County Executive recommends that the Board authorize staff to publish the advertisement for a public hearing.

#### TIMING:

Board Action is requested on March 14, 2017 to provide sufficient time to advertise the proposed public hearing on April 4, at 4:00 p.m. and April 5 and 6, 2017 at 1:00 p.m.

#### BACKGROUND:

As the *FY 2017 Third Quarter Review* includes proposed adjustments in appropriation greater than one percent of total expenditures, a public hearing is required prior to Board action. In addition, the Code of Virginia requires that a synopsis of proposed changes be included in the advertisement.

The School Board funding adjustments included in the advertisement are based on staff's Third Quarter recommendations to the School Board, which were presented to the School Board on March 9, 2017 with action to be taken by the School Board on March 23, 2017.
