### Alcohol Safety Action Program

#### Objective

To deter individuals arrested and convicted of driving under the influence of alcohol (DUI) from becoming repeat offenders by providing a comprehensive alcohol/drug education program that results in 84 percent or more of the individuals successfully completing the program.
