## **Board of Supervisors**

### Mission

To serve as Fairfax County's governing body under the Urban County Executive form of government, to make policy for the administration of the County government within the framework of the Constitution and the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, and to document those actions accordingly.

### **Focus**

The ten-member Board of Supervisors makes policy for the administration of the County government within the framework of the Constitution and laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, and the Urban County Executive form of government. Nine members of the Board of Supervisors are elected from County Supervisory districts, while the Chairman is elected at-large.

The Board of Supervisors establishes County government policies, passes resolutions and ordinances (within the limits of its authority established by the Virginia General Assembly), approves the budget, sets local tax rates, approves land use plans, and makes appointments to various positions.

# FY 2024 Funding Adjustments

The following funding adjustments from the <u>FY 2023 Adopted Budget Plan</u> are necessary to support the FY 2024 program. Included are all adjustments recommended by the County Executive that were approved by the Board of Supervisors, as well as any additional Board of Supervisors' actions, as approved in the adoption of the Budget on May 9, 2023.

#### **Employee Compensation**

\$497,571

An increase of \$497,571 in Personnel Services includes \$355,221 for a 5.44 percent market rate adjustment (MRA) for all employees and \$142,350 for performance-based and longevity increases for non-uniformed merit employees, both effective July 2023.

#### **Board of Supervisors' Salary Increase**

\$146,145

An increase of \$146,145 in Personnel Services is necessary to fund a change to the next elected Board members' annual salaries from \$95,000 to \$123,283 and the chairperson's salary from \$100,000 to \$138,283 per year. The additional funding represents partial year funding for six months as a result of the new salary level taking effect January 2024.

#### **Targeted Vacancy Savings**

(\$25,500)

A decrease of \$25,500 is included to recognize targeted vacancy savings. Although the County has taken actions to reduce the vacancy rate, it is anticipated that vacancies will remain high for the foreseeable future, generating flexibility in agency budgets.
