

Response to Questions on the FY 2010 County's Line of Business & Schools Program Review Processes Fall 2008

Request By: Supervisor Foust

Question: What is the cost per student for the Head Start program? How does this compare to other

jurisdictions?

Response: Head Start is a national child and family development program that provides early childhood

education and comprehensive family support services to income eligible families with children birth to 5 years of age, and expectant parents. Head Start promotes school readiness and self-sufficiency for low-income children and families by enhancing the social and cognitive development of children, and by providing comprehensive family services that include early childhood education; health, mental health, dental, nutrition, prenatal and social services; and

parent involvement opportunities and education.

Cost data and information on program operations were requested from surrounding local jurisdictions including City of Alexandria, VA, Arlington County, VA, Loudoun County, VA, Montgomery County, MD and Prince William County, VA. Cost data was not available for Arlington and Prince William Counties. Please note that localities calculate cost per pupil using different factors, and may or may not include costs such as transportation, food, space, etc. in the calculations. Therefore, it can be difficult to make cost comparisons across jurisdictions as cost per pupil can vary significantly.

In Fairfax County, the average cost per pupil for all Head Start programs is \$13,820 and all but two of the classrooms are full day. In Montgomery County, MD the majority of Head Start classrooms are half day, with a cost per pupil of \$7,700. The cost per pupil in Alexandria, VA is \$9,127, although it should be noted that Alexandria does not run a full year program. Staff from Loudoun County, VA report the cost per pupil is \$13,271 and the classrooms are half day. The table below details the cost and program operations data gathered for each jurisdiction.
