ORDER

CAME THIS DAY, the accused, Darwin Martinez Torres, by counsel, on Defense *Motion for Appointment of a Qualified Bilingual and Culturally Competent Mitigation Specialist* (DMT-04), and authorizing funding therefore, and it appearing proper to do so, the motion is hereby **GRANTED**. Accordingly, it is


ORDERED that the Court appoints Susan Herrero, as the defense mitigation specialist, and authorizes a fee of \$120 an hour, plus reasonable expenses, for up to 300 hours, requested constitute reasonable estimates of the work to be done and all vouchers will be reviewed and approved on an individual basis; and

plus up to \$3.500 for travel-related expenses.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all vouchers and time sheets submitted by the Ms. Herrero shall be filed under seal and may be submitted on an interim basis.
