It is FURTHER ORDERED that the question to which Dr. Murrie will respond in his assessment is: "What is your expert opinion as to how Mr. Martinez Torres's behavior pattern while in custody/incarceration impacts his future prison adaptability?"

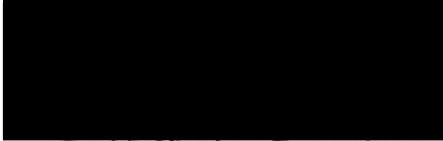

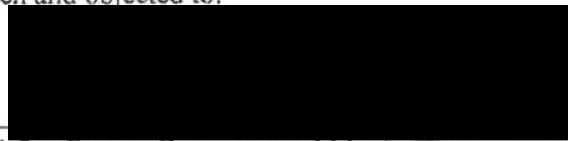
