CRIMINAL DIVISION - 4 EASY WAYS TO PAY

Whether you have established a Payment Plan Agreement with the Court, or prefer to pay all your Fines, Costs and/or Victim Restitution at one time, methods of payment include:

- 1) Cash: Paid at the Court Only (Please DO NOT send cash payments by mail.)
- 2) Money Orders, Cashier's Checks and Certified Checks:
 - Please make checks payable to Clerk of the Circuit Court.
 - Include the Defendant's name and case number on the payment.
 - If Restitution is owed, all payments will be applied first to Restitution. Once all Restitution is paid in full, payments will be applied to Court Costs.
 - If paying by mail, please include a self-addressed stamped envelope, if you would like a receipt mailed back to you.
- 3) Personal Checks*: (<u>NOT</u> accepted for Victim Restitution Payments and <u>will be</u> returned if Restitution is owed.)
 - Your name and address must be *pre-printed* on the check by your financial institution (i.e.: no "*starter checks*" accepted).
 - Address on the check must be the same as the address on your identification.
 - Third-party checks are NOT accepted.
 - Please make checks payable to Clerk of the Circuit Court.
 - Include the Defendant's **<u>name</u>** and **<u>case number</u>** on the payment.
 - If paying by mail, please include a self-addressed stamped envelope, if you would like a receipt mailed back to you.
- 4) Visa/MasterCard*: (NOT accepted for Victim Restitution Payments)
 - Payments can be made on-line at: <u>www.CitePayUSA.com</u> or <u>www.MobiLe.CitePayUSA.com/?agency=FairFaxCC</u>
 - 4% of the amount charged will be assessed as a service fee.

*Personal Checks / Visa and MasterCard payments will not be accepted from anyone, or on anyone's behalf, who has been convicted of any type of fraud pursuant to §19.2-353.3 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, such as:

- Check/Credit Card Fraud or Forgery
- o Embezzlement
- o Obtaining Money or Property under False Pretense
