Original Will & Codicils, if applicable. (The Will and Codicil(s) are retained by the Clerk.)
Certified copy of the death certificate. (The certified copy is returned to you.)
Approximate value of any solely held asset(s) (Assets include real estate and personal property.)
Names, ages & addresses of the heirs-at-law. (These are the decedent's closest relatives, pursuant to $\S64.2-200$. They may be different than the Will's beneficiaries.)
Valid photo identification
Payment in the form of cash, check, Visa or MasterCard for probate tax & fees. (There is a 4% service fee for each credit card transaction.)
If you need to serve as the personal representative of the estate and you aren't a Virginia resident, please call the Probate Division at 703-691-7320 (press 3, 5) TTY 711.
If the decedent died in a nursing home, please bring the address of the decedent's residence prior to entering the nursing home with you.
Please remember to allow ample time to park and to get through security.
