**COMMONWEALTH'S ATTORNEY STEVE DESCANO ANNOUNCES
SENTENCE IN VIRAL CYBERTRUCK/LAMBORGHINI STREET RACE CASE**

Fairfax County, VA — Commonwealth's Attorney Steve Descano announced today that Carlos Montero, 38, of Sterling, was sentenced to 90 days in jail for street racing a Lamborghini alongside a Cybertruck on October 13, 2024. A judge suspended 85/90 days and imposed a fine of \$1000, with \$250 suspended, for the reckless driving charge, and an additional \$200 for a highway traffic infraction.

On March 24, 2025, both Montero and the driver of the Cybertruck, Christian Camacho, 48, of Vienna, were convicted of misdemeanor reckless driving. Camacho's sentencing hearing, also originally scheduled for today, was continued until August 28.

In a video posted on Twitter/X and shared by Tesla CEO Elon Musk, which garnered over 150 million views, Camacho and Montero are seen street racing in a Cybertruck and a Lamborghini near Westwood Center Drive and Leesburg Pike in Tysons Center. In the video, the Lamborghini turns onto Leesburg Pike and pulls up next to the Cybertruck, which is stopped in the crosswalk of the intersection. The "flagger," who can be heard yelling "you guys ready?" testified at trial.

"This reckless behavior attracted a lot of online attention—I hope the consequences do as well," said CA Descano. "Plain and simple: street racing is dangerous, it needlessly puts the lives of others at risk, and it has no place on the highways and roads that you and your family frequent."
