WEEKLY UPDATE: WHAT WE'RE DOING FOR YOU

My biggest priority is keeping you safe. Right now, Fairfax is the safest county of its size in the nation – a testament to the work of our prosecutors and public safety officials. When a crime is committed that impacts public safety, we do everything possible to seek accountability. Below, you can see a snapshot of the work we did this past week to protect you, your family, and our larger Fairfax community.



KEEPING OUR ROADS SAFE FOR DRIVERS

Prosecuting crimes like DUIs, reckless driving, and hit-and-runs

LAST WEEK, WE PROSECUTED:

- A 23 y/o who, while intoxicated, drove into oncoming traffic and collided with another vehicle, permanently injuring the other driver
- A 35 y/o who, while intoxicated, led police on a high-speed pursuit

PROTECTING OUR COMMUNITY FROM THEFT AND FRAUD

Prosecuting crimes like embezzlement, major theft, and property loss

LAST WEEK, WE PROSECUTED:

- A 26 y/o who stole essential mechanical tools from an autobody shop
- A 29 y/o store employee who embezzled money from his employer over a six-month period
- A 55 y/o who stole and destroyed electric guitars from a storage unit

SECURING JUSTICE FOR VICTIMS OF VIOLENT CRIMES

Prosecuting violent crimes like arson, murder, and assault

LAST WEEK, WE PROSECUTED:

- A 39 y/o who, over the course of a year, sexually abused a pre-teen who lived with him
- A 19 y/o who robbed a minor at gunpoint of his phone and earbuds
