# Overview

- Federal-/State-funded Medicaid waiver required for Day and Employment Services
- Demand for waivers greater than state funding provided



# Local Day & Employment Services

5

- Began in early 1990s
- Funded through county budget
- Services provided through the Fairfax-Falls Church Community Services Board (CSB)



# Changes in Disability Services

- Increased graduation rates of students with disabilities
- Medicaid waiver redesign expanded eligibility to include developmental disabilities
- Program name change to Developmental Disabilities



# 2017 Board of Supervisors Budget Guidance

- Continue to analyze the impact of changes in developmental services
- Continue broad community collaboration
