Introduction



The June 2024 service changes focus on several routes in different portions of the County:

Route 335 is being realigned due to changes in and around Ft. Belvoir

Routes 371 and 598 are new routes funded through toll revenue grants

Route 494 would feature improved frequency with connection to new Springfield garage

Route 558 would be split into two different routes
