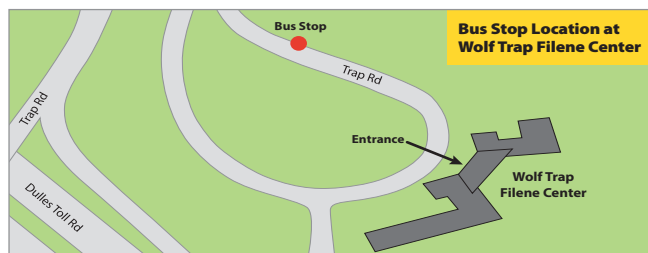
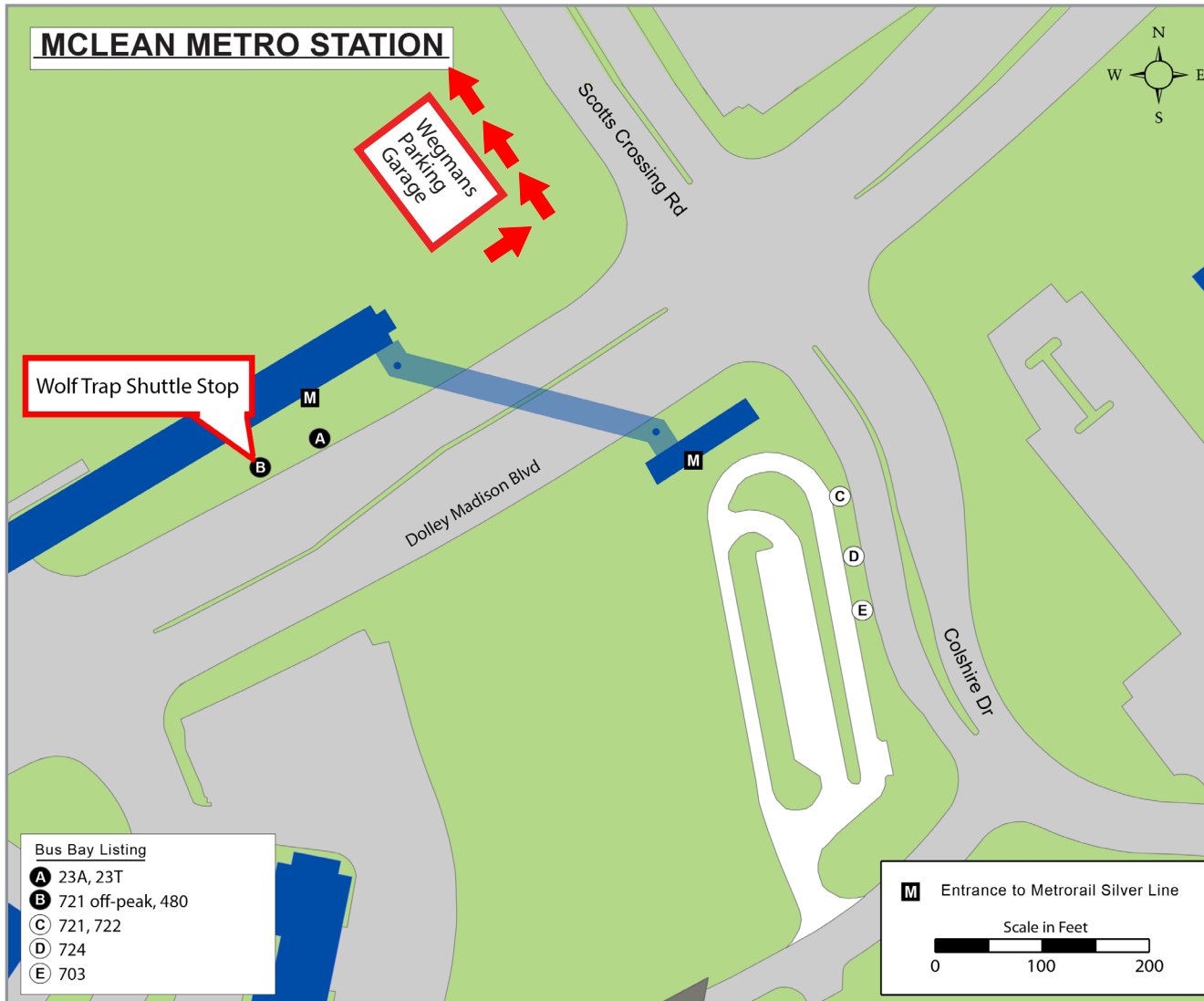

Service to Wolf Trap's Filene Center

- Service **begins two hours prior** to performances at Wolf Trap's Filene Center.
- All trips operate from McLean Metro Station at approximately **20-minute intervals**.
- The last express bus from McLean Metro to the Filene Center **departs at showtime**.

Return Service to McLean Metro

- Return trips depart Wolf Trap's Filene Center **20 minutes after the performance ends**.

Return trips depart Wolf Trap's Filene Center 20 minutes after the performance ends, but no later than:

- 11:15 pm Sunday – Thursday
- 12:00 am Friday and Saturday

McLean Metrorail Station-Eastbound:

- 11:34 pm Sunday – Thursday
- 12:34 am Friday and Saturday

McLean Metrorail Station-Westbound:

- 12:38 pm Sunday – Thursday
- 1:38 am Friday and Saturday

Round Trip Fare Amount

- **\$5 Cash**
- **\$5 SmarTrip®**
- **\$3.00 SmarTrip®** with Rail to Bus Transfer
- Kids 12 and under ride free with a paying adult
- Fairfax County 7th-12th graders ride free with a Free Student Bus Pass

- Use exact fare; drivers do not carry change.
- Foldable scooters must be folded on the bus. Rental scooters are not permitted.

- Strollers can remain open, with wheels locked, if ADA seating is not in use.
- Use earphones with audio and video devices.

- Service animals are permitted on the bus. Other small animals are permitted only if transported in a closed pet carrier.
