
Proposed Service Change Highlights

- New Route 308 providing weekday and Saturday service between Franconia-Springfield and Mount Vernon Hospital
- Add one morning and one afternoon trip to Route 699 to help address capacity issues.
- Shift headways to 30 minutes during peak and minor reroute to address ontime performance issues on Routes 321/322.
- Shift timing between Routes 161 and 162 to address on-time performance issues. Eliminate one late-night trip on Route 161 due to low ridership.
- New Route 467 providing mid-day and late evening service connecting the Vienna Park neighborhood to employment, shopping and service destinations in the Mosaic District, the Town of Vienna, and Tysons
 - public meeting for this route was held in September 2018



Route 308: Franconia/Springfield – Mount Vernon Hospital

- This new route will provide a one-seat connection between several communities and key destinations, including:
 - Franconia-Springfield
 Metrorail/VRE Station and neighboring communities
 - Kingstowne Community
 - New Village Hilltop Retail
 Center, which includes a
 Wegmans superstore
 - Lansdowne Centre








Route 321/322: Greater Springfield Circulator




