





SERVICE CHANGES OVERVIEW

FCDOT proposes the below adjustments to Connector bus service. If approved by the County Board of Supervisors, these changes would take effect in January 2023.


Service Changes

- **Route 644:** Route eliminated and replaced with new Route 660.
- **Route 660:** Route will replace 644. Provides service between Centreville (Stone Rd) Park & Ride Lot and Tysons, via Government Center and Vienna Metrorail Station. Will utilize new I-66 express lanes for faster service.

Amendments to Reston-Herndon Service Plan (Approved Feb 22, 2022)

- **Route 937:** Minor change proposed to ensure safer turning movement for buses. Southbound service realigned to serve Coppermine Rd, with left turn to Frying Pan Rd. Northbound remains unchanged.
- **Route 951:** Minor change proposed to ensure safer turning movement for buses. Eastbound service realigned to serve Coppermine Rd, with left turn to Frying Pan Rd. Westbound remains unchanged.




