- Q1. Will there be a Pre-Proposal Conference for this contract?
- A1. There will not be a pre-proposal.
- Q2. Is there a bid sheet/price sheet to be completed or should we make our own?
- A2. There is not a pricing schedule provided, offerors should submit pricing per the requirements listed in the RFP Special Provisions, Section 13.
- Q3. What is the current Prevailing wage rate number that will be used for this contract? The web site provided does not provide this information.
- A3. There is not a current Prevailing wage rate number as this information will be pulled on a project-by-project basis if the total cost exceeds \$250K.
- Q4. What is the % of Prevailing wage work issued in the past awarded contracts?
- A4. Approximately 90%.
- Q5. What is the estimated % of future work will be Prevailing wage?
- A5. Unfortunately, this is difficult to project, as there may be cancelled, planned, and other unplanned projects that develop in a given fiscal year.
- Q6. Will the contact use one wage decision for the entire 3-year duration or will each task follow the wage decision for that year?
- A6. Wage decisions will be pulled on a project-by-project basis if the total cost exceeds \$250K.
- Q7. If Prevailing Wage rate does change how is this addressed by the labor rates provided in the contract?
- A7. County does not establish the Prevailing Wage criteria, as this is a function and process requirement for the Department of Labor (DOLI) for Commonwealth of VA. This information will be pulled on a project-to-project basis if the total exceeds \$250K. How you propose your labor rates in your proposal response regarding prevailing wages is a business decision.
- Q8. If there is a wage decision for this RFP, can you please provide a copy with the decision number?
- A8. Please see response to Question 3.
- Q9. I don't see any plans or specs on the Bonfire site for the upcoming RFP 2000003898 HVAC & Plumbing System Installation & Replacement bid. Am I missing something?
