Community Assessment: Persons 65 Years and Older


In 2000, a Community Assessment was conducted jointly by Fairfax County, the City of Fairfax, the City of Falls Church, and the Fairfax–Falls Church United Way to gather information about people in our community and to assist in human services planning. In September 2000, the survey was mailed to 11,200 households in the two Cities and the County. The response rate was 6,859 households or 63 percent after compensating for vacant housing and incorrect addresses. This was the second Community Assessment; the first survey was conducted in 1995.

This publication profiles persons, age 65 and older, and households containing persons, age 65 and older, in the five Human Services Regions, the Cities of Fairfax and Falls Church, and the Total Area. The tables contain person level data about sex, race/ethnicity, English proficiency, educational attainment, employment status, adult day care needs, health insurance coverage, mental health issues, longlasting conditions, and poverty levels. The tables also contain household data on household size, language spoken at home, Internet access, income, housing type and tenure, housing costs, financial difficulties, and moving a senior or disabled person here from outside the area.
