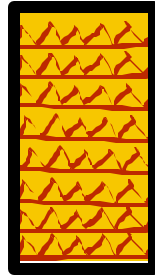

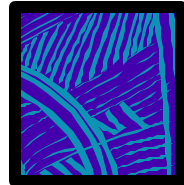


100% Feel it is important for their children to graduate from high school.

96.9% Feel it is important for their children to attend college.

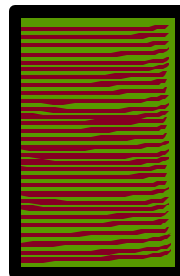


70.8% Know most of their children's friends very well.

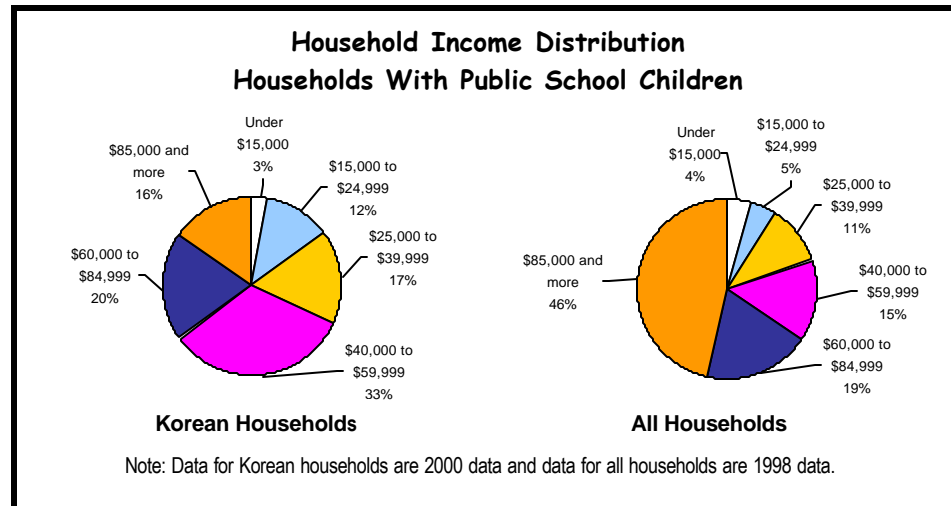
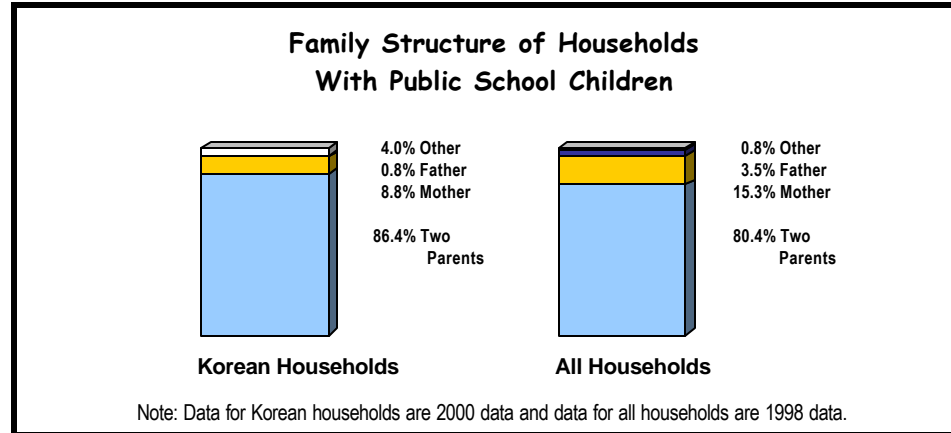


85.1% Believe the people of the United States make their family feel welcome.

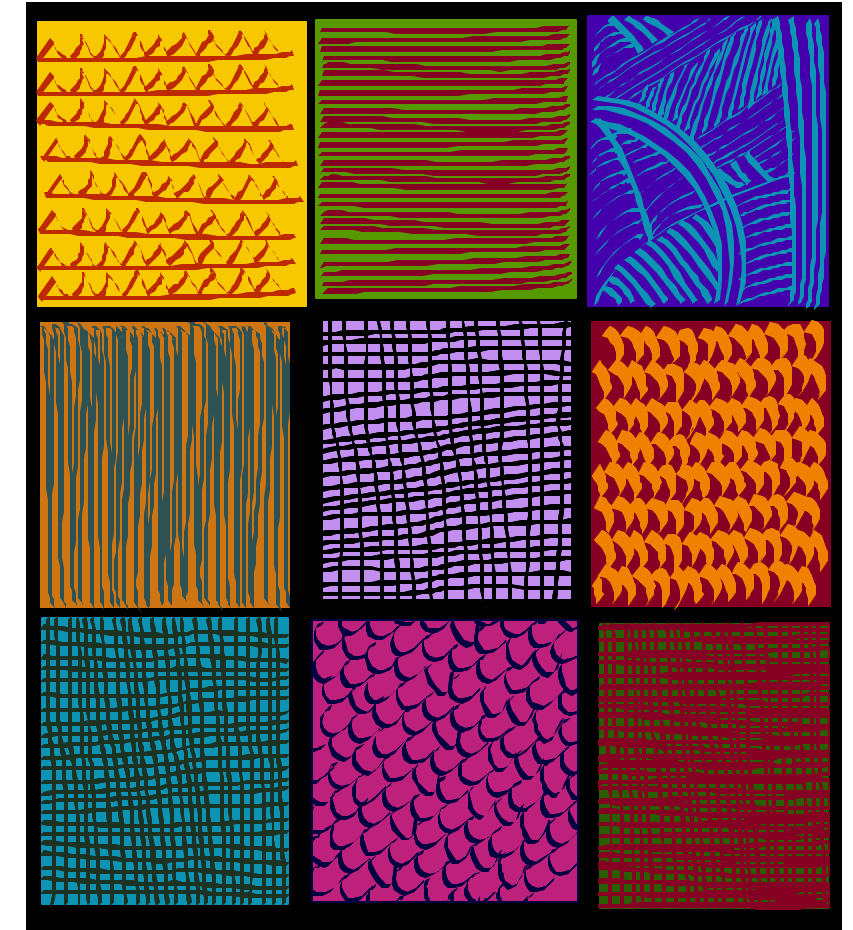

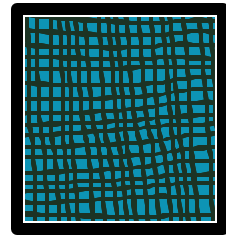

Korean Households With Public School Children

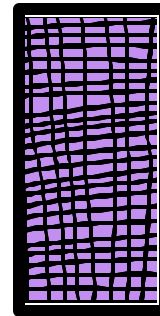

Note: The data in this report are based on a sample of 130 households. The results of this sample are representative of the approximately 2,500 households with children enrolled in Fairfax County Public Schools that indicated their primary language as Korean. As of January 2000, Fairfax County had a projected 353,400 households.
