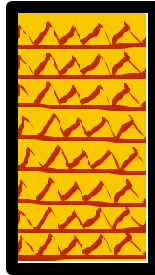


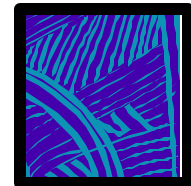
Community Strengths



99.6% Feel it is important for their children to graduate from high school.

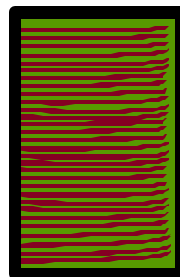
99.2% Feel it is important for their children to attend college.

60.8% Know most of their children's friends very well.

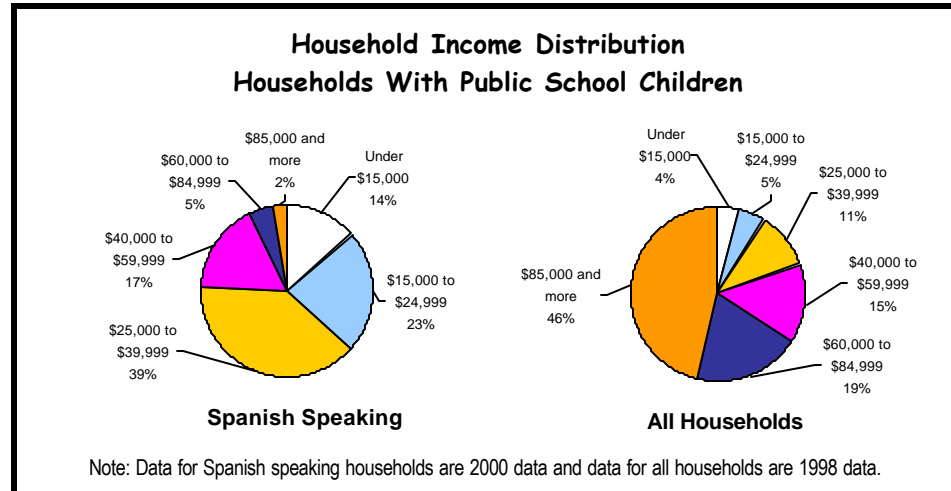
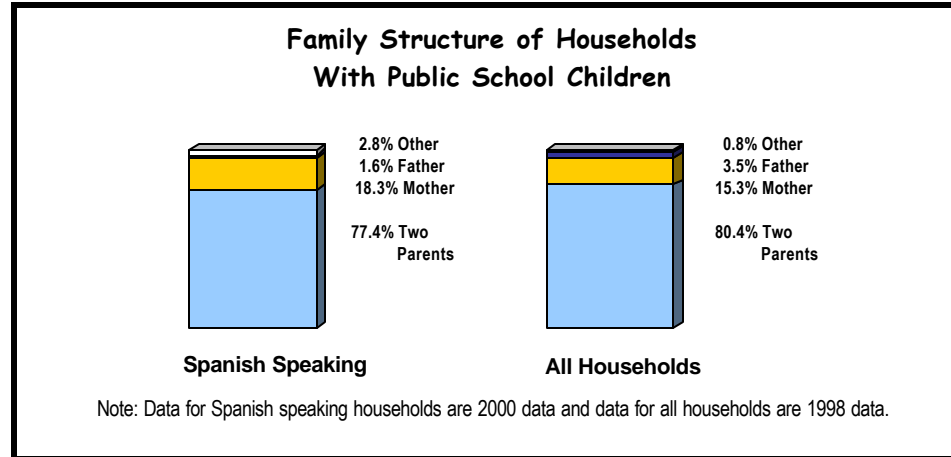


81.7% Believe the people of the United States make their family feel welcome.

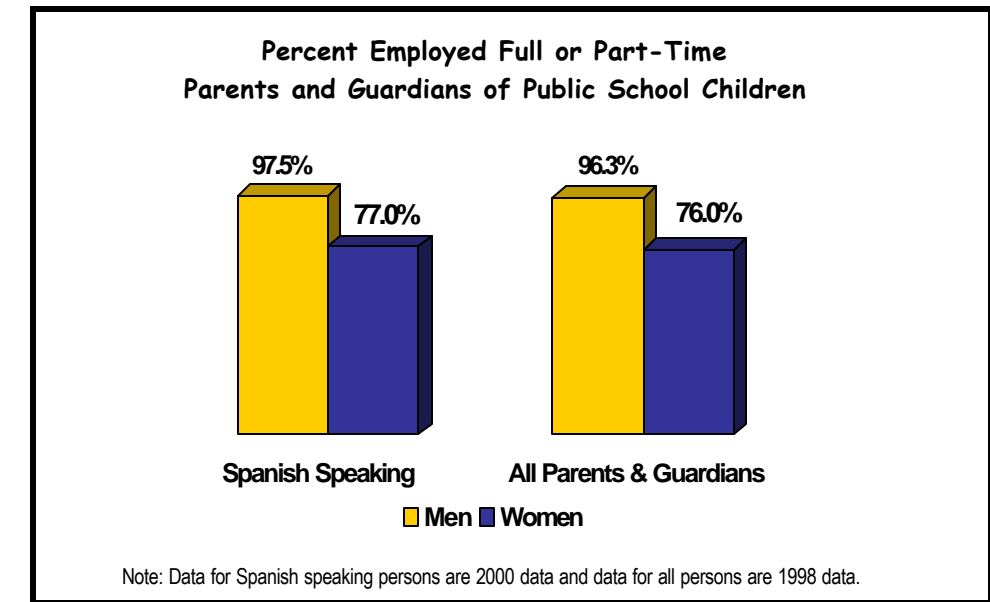

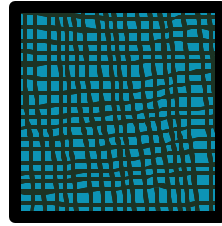

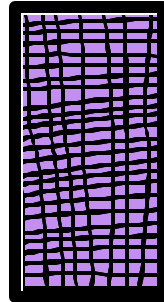




97.4% Have at least one parent or guardian who is employed.

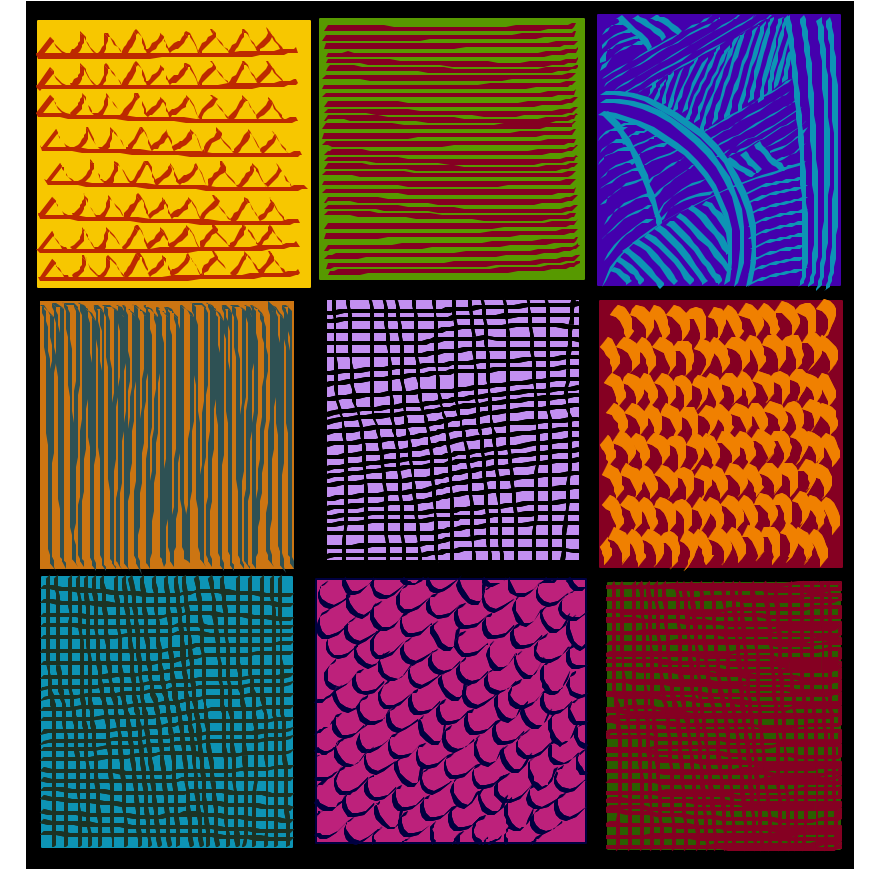
