Northern Virginia Community College

NOVA at a glance:

- 3rd largest community college in nation and most diverse college in Virginia
- Average student is 24.4 and average class size is 24
- Region ranks 4th in nation in job openings but 18th out of 20 in labor force growth

NOVA is the top supplier of talent in the region with almost 80,000 students.

HS Dual Enrollment

- In Fall 2022, NOVA's HSDE program offered in partnership with Fairfax County Public Schools resulted in an effective scholarship for Fairfax families of over **\$4,600,000**
- Enrollment in the program grew more than **30%** between Fall 2021 and Fall 2022

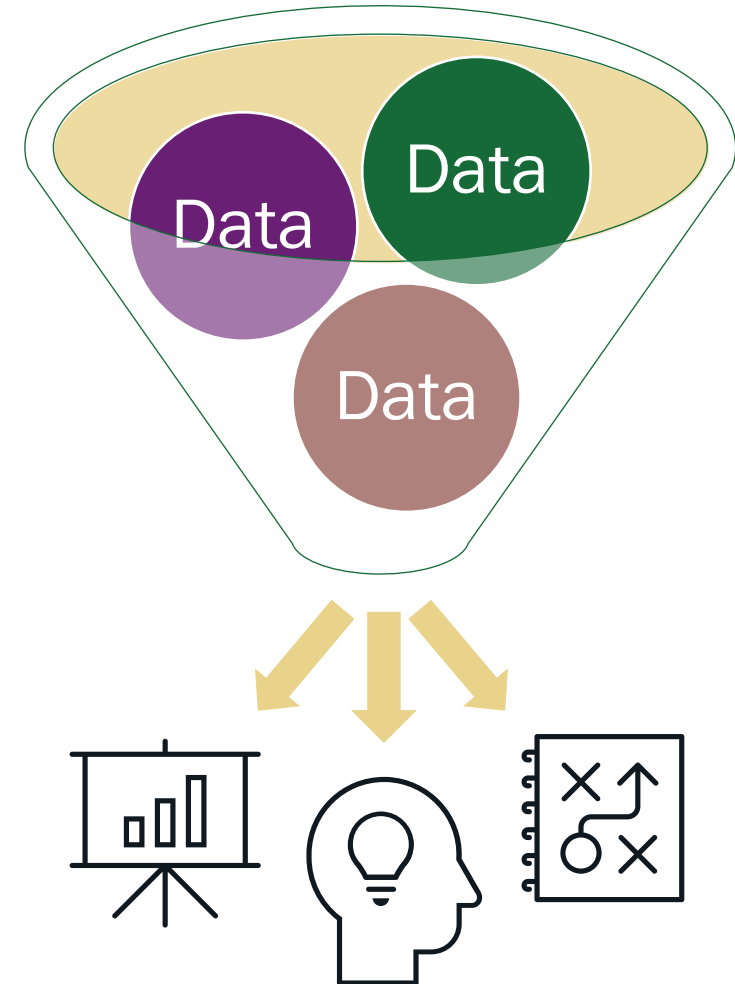

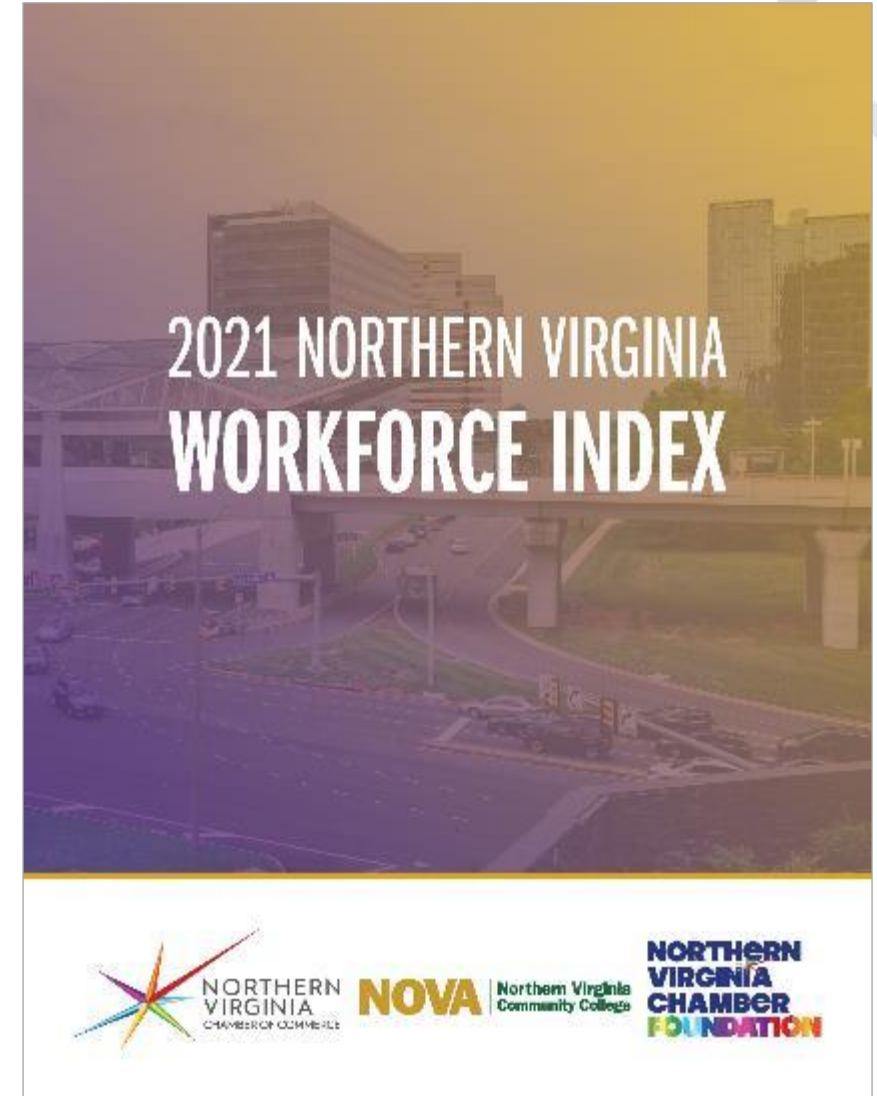

NORTHERN VIRGINIA WORKFORCE INDEX

Annual survey of businesses in Northern Virginia, tracking regional trends in hiring, retention, educational requirements, and training/professional development

2021 Findings:

- Northern Virginia weathered the pandemic better than many other regions economically
- Businesses are still facing meaningful challenges in finding and hiring talent due to labor shortages.
- Most employers rely on traditional strategies for hiring and recruitment
- Opportunity for regional employers to **expand their talent pipelines through programs like apprenticeships.**

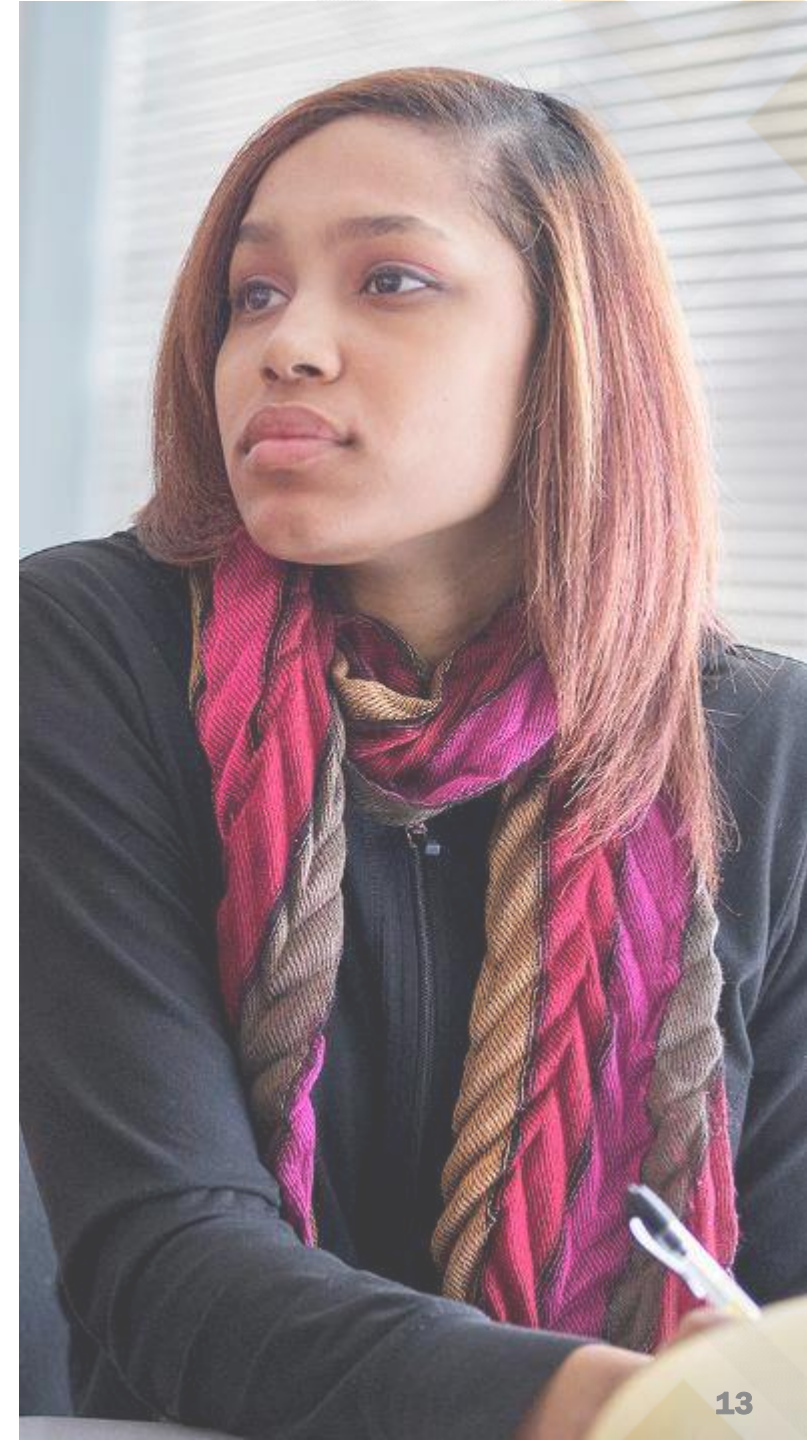
NOVA in Context Post-Pandemic

- Recognized by the Aspen Institute for our ADVANCE partnership with George Mason University

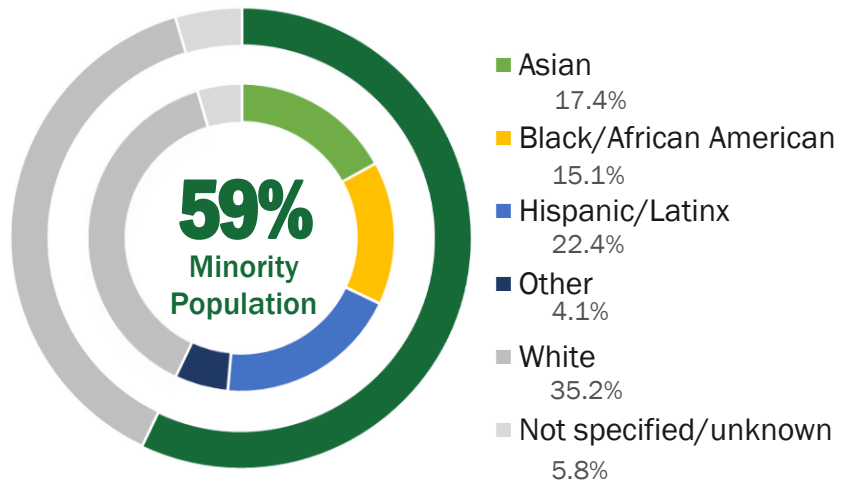
OUR STUDENTS

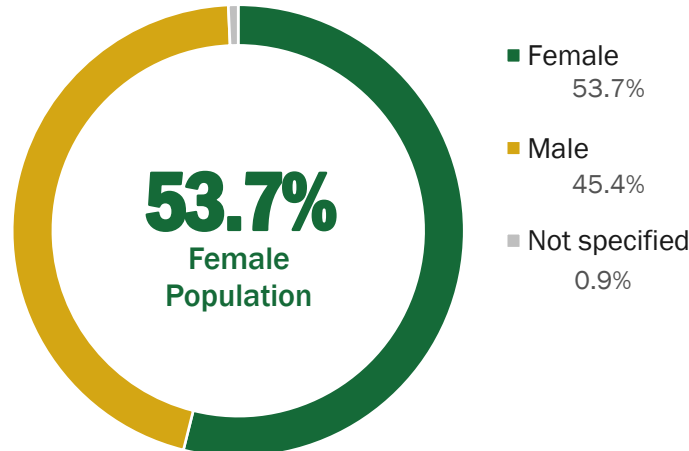

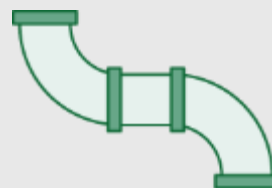
