# Northern Virginia Community College

NOVA at a glance:

- 3rd largest community college in nation and most diverse college in Virginia
- Average student is 24.4 and average class size is 24
- Region ranks 4<sup>th</sup> in nation in job openings but 18<sup>th</sup> out of 20 in labor force growth

NOVA is the top supplier of talent in the region with almost 80,000 students.

# **HS Dual Enrollment**

- In Fall 2022, NOVA's HSDE program offered in partnership with Fairfax County Public Schools resulted in an effective scholarship for Fairfax families of over \$4,600,000
- Enrollment in the program grew more than 30% between Fall 2021 and Fall 2022





Annual survey of businesses in Northern Virginia, tracking regional trends in hiring, retention, educational requirements, and training/professional development


#### 2021 Findings:


- Northern Virginia weathered the pandemic better than many other regions economically


# **NOVA in Context Post-Pandemic**




