March 5, 2024 – Democratic and Republican Presidential Primaries

Deadline to register to vote:

- In person*Feb. 12 at 5:00 p.m.
- OnlineFeb. 12 at 11:59 p.m.
- By mail.....must be postmarked by Feb. 12

*Between Feb. 13 and Mar. 2, voters may submit a same day registration and vote using a provisional ballot at an early voting location.
On Election Day, Mar. 5, voters may submit a same day registration and vote using a provisional ballot at their polling place (precinct).

Deadline to apply to Vote by Mail:

- Online, in person, or by mail.....Feb. 23 at 5:00 p.m.

Deadline to return Vote by Mail ballots to be counted:

- Deposited in a drop box or hand delivered to officeMar. 5 at 7:00 p.m.
- Mailed ballot.....must be postmarked by Mar. 5 and received by noon on Mar. 8
