Electoral Board Meeting

Pursuant to Va. Code § 24.2-671, the Fairfax County Electoral Board will meet beginning at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, November 6, 2024, subject to recess and reconvening, to canvass the returns and ascertain the results of the General and Special Elections held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. This meeting will be held in Conference Room 251, Fairfax County Government Center, 12000 Government Center Parkway, Fairfax. General election matters may be discussed. The write-in certification process will take place in Conference Room 251, Fairfax County Government Center, beginning at 10:00 a.m.

Additionally, pursuant to Va. Code § 24.2-653.01, the Electoral Board will meet beginning at 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 6, 2024, subject to recess and reconvening, to determine the qualifications of each person, if any, who submitted a provisional ballot for the General and Special Elections held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. The Board will go into Closed Session to consider the qualifications of provisional voters. Other than appropriate staff and legal counsel of the Electoral Board, attendance at this meeting shall be permitted for the persons whose provisional votes are being considered with their legal counsel, if present, as well as one authorized representative of each political party or independent candidate. Authorized representatives must be qualified voters in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
