* After Oct. 16, voters may do a same day registration at a voting location or at the Office of Elections and vote using a provisional ballot.

Date when first vote by mail ballots will be mailed/mailed out.....Sept. 22

Deadline to apply to vote by mail:

Online or in office.....Oct. 27 at 5:00 p.m.

Deadline for return of vote by mail ballots to be counted:

Deposited in a drop box or hand-delivered to office..... Nov. 7 at 7:00 p.m.
Mailed ballot must be postmarked on or before Nov. 7 and received by Nov. 13 at noon
