**Agenda Items, Discussion, Decisions and Votes**

Chair Zaragoza called the meeting to order at 5:05 pm. He then moved that the Fairfax County Environmental Quality Advisory Council (EQAC) go into Closed Session, pursuant to Virginia Code Section 2.2-3711(A)(19) for the purpose of discussion of information subject to the exclusion in subdivision 2 or 14 of § 2.2-3705.2, where discussion in an open meeting would jeopardize the safety of any person or the security of any facility, building, structure, information technology system, or software program. The subject matter was a tour of a Fairfax County

water recycling facility. The motion was seconded by Dr. Goplerud, and it carried by a vote of 8-0-0.

At the conclusion of the facility tour and in accordance with Virginia Code Section 2.2-3712, Chair Zaragoza moved that the members certify that, to the best of each member's knowledge, only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements under the Virginia Freedom of Information Act and only such public business matters as were identified in the motion by which the closed meeting was convened were consulted upon, heard, discussed or considered in the closed session meeting by the Fairfax County EQAC. The motion was seconded by Dr. Wiseman, and it carried by a vote of 8-0-0.

Chair Zaragoza then adjourned the meeting.
