# Environmental Benefits

- Decreased impervious surface in parking areas
- Reduced fluid pollutants
- Reduced heat island effect
- Improved storm water management and mitigation
- Reduced vehicle emissions

# Draft Ordinance Examples

- Parking adjustments to conserve or enhance existing trees or greenspace (Draft Subsection 6100.1.A.(6) & 6100.6.G);
- Counting of EVC spaces towards required parking (Draft Subsection 6100.3.E);
- Permitting alternative surfaces such as semi-porous grid paving systems in parking areas (Draft Subsection 6100.2.C(3))
- Parking redesignation plans no longer required for installation of EVC, solar canopies or bicycle parking infrastructure (Draft Subsection 6100.2.C(4))

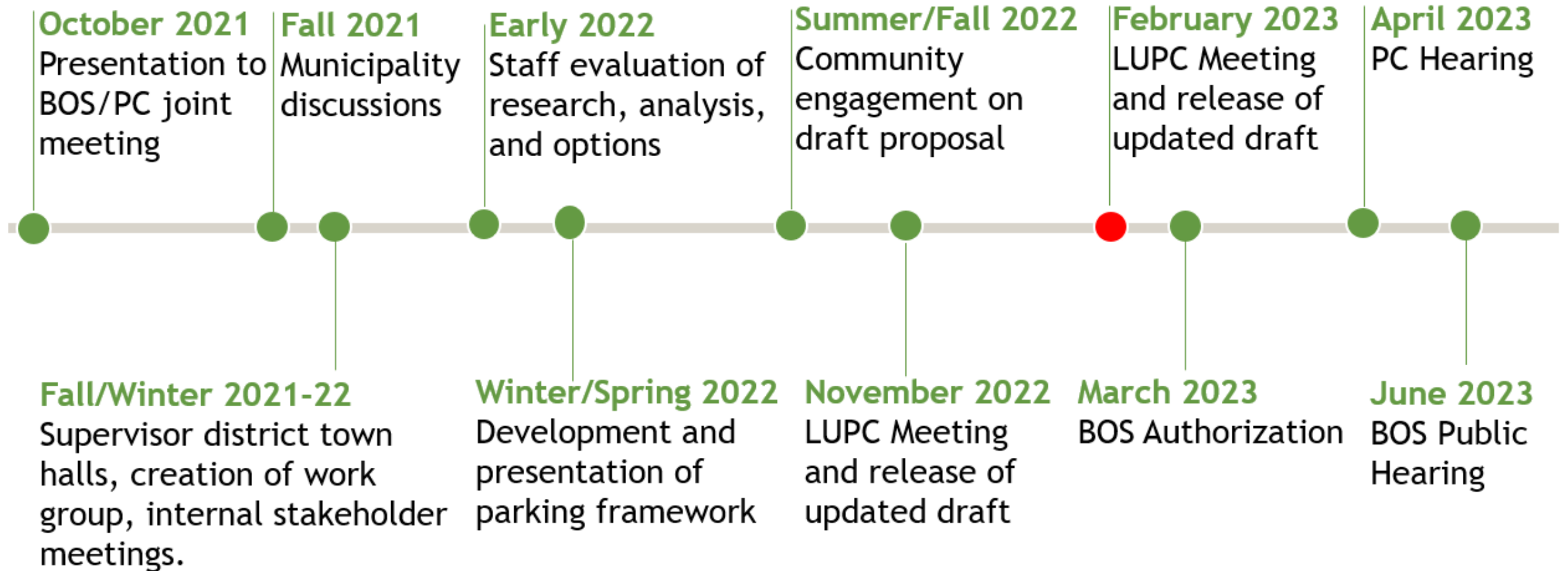
# How does Parking Reimagined support CECAP

- Streamlining of processes related to EVC and solar canopy installation (Supports CECAP Strategies 5 & 7)
- Implementation of bicycle parking minimum requirements (Supports CECAP Strategy 8a)
- Tiered framework which reduces parking rates in densely populated areas with better access to public transit (Supports CECAP Strategies 8b & 8c)
- Implementation of pedestrian route standards (Supports CECAP Strategy 8)

# How does Parking Reimagined support Resilient Fairfax and One Fairfax

- Reduced parking requirements reduce required parking infrastructure. This reduces heat-generating land development activities (Supports Resilient Fairfax Strategy CRC. 3)
- Decreasing of impervious surface requirements (Supports Resilient Fairfax Strategy CRC.3b)
- Adjustment of parking requirements to conserve or enhance greenspace and tree canopy (Supports Resilient Fairfax Goals AE.1 & AE.2)
- Promotes in part a quality-built environment that accommodates anticipated growth and promotes housing and services for all people (Aligns with One Fairfax Area of Focus #11)
