


## Fairfax County Annual Recycling Rate

#### **Annual Recycling Rate Fairfax County**






### RECYCLING RATE CY2019 vs CY2020



# No More Plastic Bags for Yard Waste!

Beginning on March 1, 2021, Fairfax County will no longer allow the use of plastic bags for the collection of yard waste.

Plastic bags are bad for the environment—they get torn and mixed in with yard waste. That becomes part of the compost that we use in our gardens, and those microplastics end up in local streams, affecting water quality.

#### What can you do instead?

- · Let the grass clippings fertilize the lawn.
- Try backyard composting.
- Use durable cans or paper yard waste bags.
