Agenda Items, Discussion, Decisions and Votes

- <u>Electronic meeting findings and determinations</u>
 Chairman Koch read the electronic meeting findings and determinations to state that the
 Environmental Quality Advisory Council was meeting electronically due to the ongoing
 COVID-19 pandemic.
- <u>Election of EQAC Chair and Vice Chair</u> Mr. Lamb and Mr. Weisman worked together to bring EQAC the nominations. Mr. Weisman moved to nominate Ms. Koch as Chairman and Mr. Zaragoza as Vice-Chair. Mr. Wilber seconded. Council passed the motion unanimously.

4. Discussion of EQAC Letter on the Litter Control Task Force

A draft letter was presented for Council's review. Mr. Wilbur moved to accept the letter to be sent to the Board of Supervisors. Mr. Zaragoza seconded. Discussion resulted in minor edits regarding capitalization and punctuation. Council passed the motion unanimously.

Ms. Grebe announced the hiring of DEQ's new NOVA EJ Coordinator, Gwen McCrea, as well FCPA's new head of their Natural Resource Management Division, Laura Grape. Ms. Grebe will draft a natural resources budget letter for February's EQAC meeting.

8. Staff items

Mr. Meyers provided an update on the February 15, 2022, Board's Environment Committee. OEEC will be updating members on CECAP, Carbon Free Fairfax, and Fairfax Green Initiatives as well. Also, staff is exploring how to ensure past meetings do not get hidden, and thus hide prior meeting content. Prior annual EQAC reports aren't posted because they were not ADA compliant. OEEC is hiring 5 positions which all close on January 14, 2022.
