## Laura,

The 2024 legislative efforts will begin with a consideration of new legislative and budget initiatives, and new policy positions for consideration by the Board of Supervisors. Here is a list of items the ASSB could submit for consideration by the Board of Supervisors.

- A new <u>legislative initiative</u> asks the board to consider a new bill or resolution for a priority issue. The
  included forms ask us to provide one paragraph, two at the most summarizing why a law needs to be
  changed or enacted, the issues involved and the impact on Fairfax County. There is an opportunity to
  add additional background information on a separate form.
- The <u>budget initiative</u> form requests information on why additional funding is required for the County;
   the impact of receiving or not receiving the funding; the number of citizens it would affect and any other relevant information. This form also requires using a separate sheet for additional information.
- A <u>new policy statement</u> form also requires concise language; would list pros and cons for the issue; mention any previous study or action on the issue and describe the impact on Fairfax County.

As you contemplate submitting initiatives and/or positions, please review the Human Service related items from the 2023 state legislative program online. Submissions from BAC's must be endorsed by the full entity and should not be proposals by individual group members. The ASSB should not feel obligated to submit a new legislative or budget initiative or policy position unless there is a particularly important need.

The specific instructions, if the ASSB chooses to make a request, are attached. Requests must be finalized for review by the DFS Director no later than **July 26**. Feel free to reach out to me if you have any further questions.
