Meetings are generally held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday evening of the Month. Commissioners typically dedicate about 5 hours a month to CFW duties.

Duties: 1) Upholding the bylaws and integrity of the CFW; 2) Being well-informed of CFW programs and activities; 3) Becoming generally familiar with County policy and available services; 4) Participating in events in your district and in the County; 5) Advancing an effective working relationship and regular communications with the District Supervisor and staff; 6) Committing a minimum of 10 hours per month to CFW-only driven tasks and/or projects consistent with CFW mission; and 7) Serving on CFW committees.
