Background

- The proposed plan was developed throughout 2019, and was first presented by the County Executive to the Board of Supervisors in February 2020
- Public process on the plan was temporarily paused in March 2020, to evaluate COVID-19 impacts and make necessary adjustments to the draft plan
- The draft plan was designed to be flexible and to adapt over time, with community input throughout the implementation process and beyond – the draft plan has been publicly posted for more than 18 months
- The Board of Supervisors will determine which elements of the proposed plan are acted upon, and when, informed by ongoing community input and data
- First steps will be to adopt a vision and a strategic direction to move Fairfax County forward, and to align and integrate our work to achieve maximum efficiency across countywide initiatives

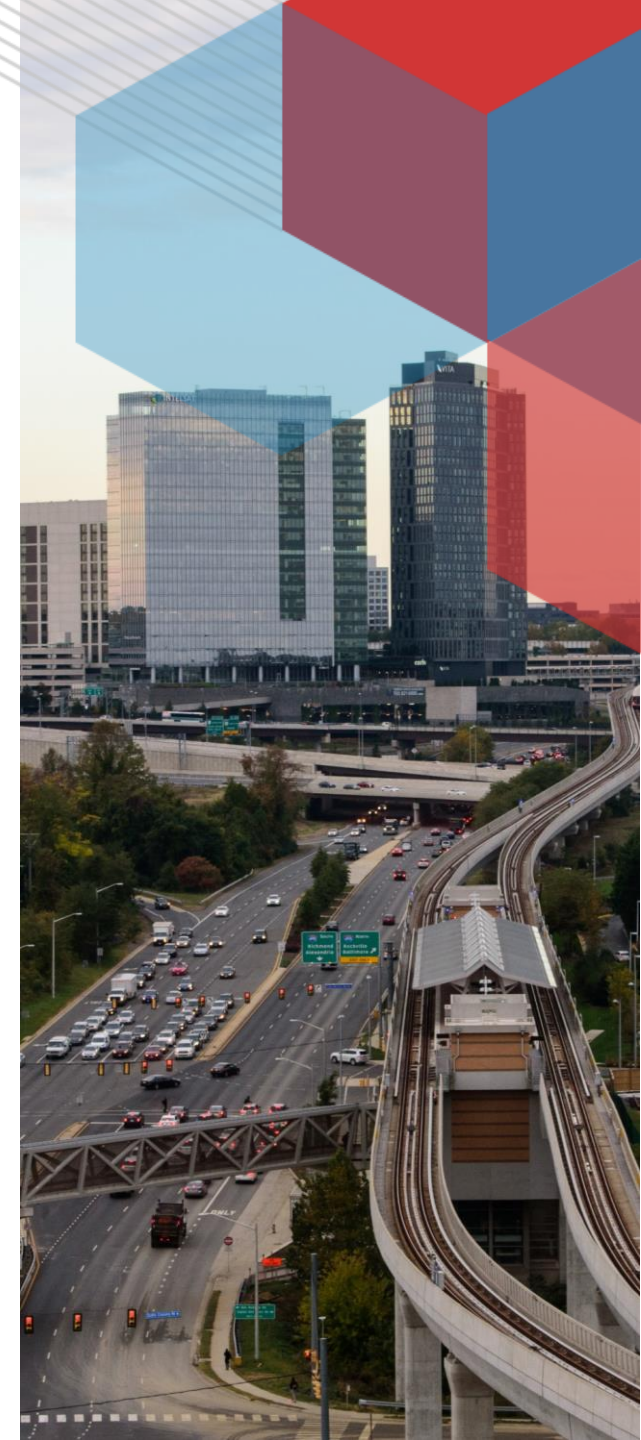

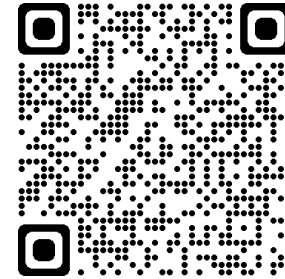

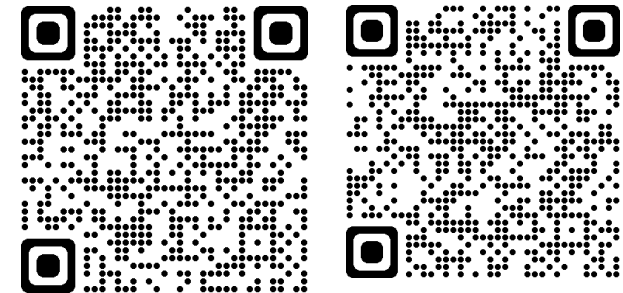
