

Accessible Voting for Voters with Disabilities



Every citizen has the right to vote.

Fairfax County is dedicated to providing accessibility to voters with disabilities.

Accessibility

- All precincts are wheelchair accessible
- Each precinct has a magnifying device for voters with low vision

Accommodations

- Accommodations can be provided upon request, including assistance marking a ballot

Curbside Voting

- Curbside voting is available at every precinct
- Voters with disabilities can vote without leaving their car
- Voters can call upon arrival to the precinct and request curbside voting

Early / Absentee Voting

- Voters can vote early in-person at the Office of Elections during office hours or extended hours scheduled through 5pm on the Saturday prior to the election
- Voters can vote early in person at a satellite location
- Voters can vote absentee by mail

Express Voting Machines

- Every precinct is equipped with an Express Voting Machine that enables independent voting
- Express Voting Machines are equipped with large buttons, Braille, and an audio headset
