The John Hudson Internship Program is open to post-secondary students who self-identify as an individual with a disability. The internship provides participants with on-the-job experience, professional development, and training opportunities.

The internship program is managed by Fairfax County Disability Rights and Resources. **The final date to submit an application for the summer 2026 program is Tuesday, March 31, 2026.**

- ▶ 380 hours total
- ▶ Earn \$19 per hour
