# **Know the Facts:** SEXUAL VIOLENCE

### WHAT IS SEXUAL VIOLENCE?

Sexual violence is any type of unwanted sexual contact, including words and actions of a sexual nature, against a person's will or without their consent.

A person might use force, threats, manipulation, intimidation, or coercion to commit sexual violence. Sexual violence is motivated by a need to control, humiliate, dominate, or harm. It can occur at any age and in any relationship (including stranger, significant other, family member, roommate, personal care provider, friend, teacher, etc.).

### Sexual violence can include, but is not limited to:

- ▶ Rape
- Nonconsensual oral sex
- ► Unwanted touching
- ► Flashing or catcalling
- ► Restricting access to birth control or condoms
- Forced viewing of pornography
- ► Taking or distributing sexual images of someone without their consent

## THE FACTS: In the U.S.

lin 2 women reported unwanted

and in 4 men sexual contact in their lifetime.

1 in 3 women reported being

and in 9 men harassed in a public place at some point in their lifetime.

More than

female (56.1%) and male (57.3%) victims of sexual violence knew their perpetrators.

in 4 reported completed or women attempted rape during her lifetime.

in 9 men reported being made to penetrate someone during his lifetime.

More than

female (83.4%) and male (86.1%) rape victims reported they were first raped before age 25 and almost half were first raped as a minor.

### In Fairfax County

9% of students reported being physically forced into having sex by a dating partner. 5% of students reported being pressured into having sex by a dating partner.

in 6 students reported experiencing sexual harassment.

1in 18 were injured
