## YELLOW DOT PROGRAM

### IT COULD SAVE YOUR LIFE

On September 12, 2016, the Fairfax County Fire and Rescue Department launched its newest public safety initiative, the Yellow Dot Program. This free program is designed to help first responders provide life-saving medical attention during the "golden hour" after a vehicle crash or emergency. Participants place a Yellow Dot decal in their vehicle's rear window to alert first responders to check the vehicle's glove compartment for vital medical information.



To participate, residents can visit their nearest Fairfax County fire station and ask for a Yellow Dot Program kit. The Yellow Dot Program kit **contains a personal information booklet** and a Yellow Dot decal. Complete both sides of the booklet as fully as possible. Filling the booklet out in pencil will allow

you to update the booklet as information changes. Attach a current photo of yourself and place the booklet in the glove compartment. Place the Yellow Dot Program decal in the lower left corner of your rear windshield, no higher than three inches from the bottom.

<p><b>The Yellow Dot Program</b></p> <p>The Yellow Dot program is a Fairfax County Public Safety partnership to help save lives during a vehicle accident or emergency situation.</p> <p>To participate, complete this information card and attach a recent photo. Place the card in your vehicle glove compartment. Affix the yellow dot decal on the driver's side of your rear vehicle's window in the bottom corner.</p> <p>During an emergency, first responders will be alerted to the yellow dot and will then look for your information form.</p> <p>If you sell your vehicle, remember to remove the information from your glove compartment and the yellow dot decal from your window.</p> <p>WWW.FAIRFAXCOUNTY.GOV</p>
