

Installation Guide for Virtual Fairfax TerraExplorer Plugin



Please note that at this time, the TerraExplorer plug-in is only supported on Microsoft Windows operating systems. If you are not using Windows, the plug-in may not install properly. There are future plans to support other operating systems (i.e. Macintosh) once the technology allows it.

If you meet the [system requirements](#) for TerraExplorer 6.6.1, please follow the steps below that describe how to download and install the plugin. **If you already have an older version of TerraExplorer, you must first uninstall it with Windows control panel before following the steps below.**

Downloading


1. Click the download () button to download the installation files.
2. A popup window will appear at the bottom of your browser window (different browsers have different popups). Click the “Run” to download the install files and begin the installation process.


- a. Click the yellow warning bar and select the “Download File...” option to proceed.
