<u>TITLE</u>: Approval of New SCYPT Membership Position

ISSUE:

SCYPT approval of an amendment to the SCYPT charter to add a position for the Fairfax County Public Schools Chief Academic Officer.

RECOMMENDATION:

The SCYPT Executive Committee recommends that the SCYPT amend its charter to add one position: the Fairfax County Public Schools Chief Academic Officer. Membership on the Executive Committee should be changed to include the FCPS Chief Equity Officer, FCPS Chief Academic Officer, and Fairfax County Chief Equity Officer.

BACKGROUND:

Having reviewed SCYPT membership, and in light of recent organizational changes within Fairfax County Public Schools (FCPS) the Executive Committee is recommending adding the FCPS Chief Academic Officer to the SCYPT membership. To maintain consistency in approach and representation, the membership of the SCYPT Executive Committee should be clarified to include the FCPS and County Chief Equity Officers and the FCPS Chief Academic Officer. Therefore, the Executive Committee should include:

- The two Board of Supervisors members;
- The two School Board members;
- The FCPS Deputy Superintendent;
- The FCPS Chief Equity Officer;
- The FCPS Chief Academic Officer;
- The Fairfax County Deputy County Executive for Health and Human Services;
- The Fairfax County Chief Equity Officer;
- The SCYPT community co-chair; and
- The SCYPT community co-chair-elect.
