How to Register for the COVID-19 Vaccine

Online

Visit fairfaxcounty.gov/covid19 to complete the registration questionnaire for a vaccine appointment. Vaccine appointments are given in order of registration. When it is your turn, you will receive an invitation to schedule an appointment.

Most COVID-19 vaccines require two doses. You will receive an invitation to schedule your second dose 4–7 days before it is due.
