Presentation and Discussion of the Proposed Amendment on Adult Day Health Care. In January 2020, the Board of Supervisors directed the Department of Planning and Development (DPD) to review the current zoning ordinance provisions related to adult day care centers and align those requirements, where appropriate, with the current requirements for child care centers, as the land use impacts associated with both types of uses are similar. Leslie Johnson, Zoning Administrator, DPD and Sara Morgan, Planner III, DPD will present a strawman of the adult day health care amendment.
