

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The Asian tiger mosquito has a black body and white stripes. Blood is its favorite meal, and it bites during the day.









orrugated Pipes





Mosquitoes fly around to find food. They like to stay near cool, shady areas but will travel far in search of blood.



The Asian tiger mosquito hides in plants like ivy, azaleas, and other shady bushes.


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
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
Cleaning up junk gets rid of places where mosquitoes can breed and also helps the environment.



After you are done playing in the kiddie pool, make sure you have an adult empty all the water out so mosquitoes can't lay their eggs.










Nectar is sugar water that all mosquitoes use for food. Only girl mosquitoes drink blood.



A virus is a small germ that can make you sick. Some viruses are carried by mosquitoes.




West Nile virus is carried by some mosquitoes and can make you sick.





Get Rid of Standing Water

- Plastic containers, trays, etc.
- Toys, playhouses, etc.
- 🗌 Planters, flower pots, etc.
- 🗌 Birdbaths, fish ponds, decorative
 - garden fixtures, etc.
- 🗌 Kiddie pools
- Old tires, tire swings

Check Drainage

- Clean gutters
- Remove or make sure corrugated
 - drainpipes on downspouts
 - do not hold water
- Clear drainage ditches of trash & junk

Look for Hidden Water

The Disease Carrying Insects Program (DCIP) was established in 2003 to monitor and control mosquitoes and West Nile virus in Fairfax County. The mission of the program is threefold: vector and disease surveillance, vector management and control as well as community education and outreach activities.
