CONTRACT ITEM C1-Child Specific Contract Request for Detroit Behavioral Institute

<u>ISSUE:</u> The Department of Family Services Foster Care and Adoption (DFS-FC&A) requests CPMT approval of a child specific Agreement for the Purchase of Services (APOS) for residential treatment with Detroit Behavioral Institute for Harmony #142912.

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: The CSA MT forwards the request to the CPMT for approval of a child specific APOS for residential treatment with Detroit Behavioral Institute for Harmony #142912.

<u>MEDICAID ENROLLMENT</u>: Detroit Behavioral Institute is a not a Virginia Medicaid enrolled provider.

<u>LICENSE/ACCREDITATION</u>: Detroit Behavioral Institute is a licensed provider of residential services by the State of Michigan Department of Health and Human Services.

<u>INSURANCE STATUS</u>: Detroit Behavioral Institute is appropriately insured in accordance with Fairfax County standards.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION (from the case worker):

Detroit Behavioral Institute — Capstone Academy (DBI-CA) was established in 2004 and designed to serve one or more emerging populations in need of varying modalities of treatment. The treatment modality is a life-long commitment to personal growth and development in order to acquire and maintain a healthy lifestyle. The goal is the program is to provide a holistic, therapeutic social environment that promotes the utilization of evidence-based treatment practices and to teach socially appropriate behaviors to residents. When practiced consistently, these learned behaviors will assist in preparing young men for their future, therefore improving the chances of their successful return to the community, and adaption to a healthy and safe lifestyle. Detroit Behavioral Institute- Capstone Academy (DBI-CA) is a secure, residential, mental health treatment facility.

DBI-CA provides therapeutic interventions to youth between the ages of 12 — 18 in a structured setting. The target population for youth accepted into this program is girls between the ages of 12 to 18 with a mental health diagnosis, minimum IQ of 70 and a secure environment. The girls who are placed at DBI with behavioral challenges which have been influenced by their familial and social environments. Issues may include truancy from home and/or school, neglect, trauma

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from physical and/or sexual abuse victimization, alcohol and/or other drug usage, and a host of serious emotional disturbances. The youth may present with self-destructive behaviors such as participation in illegal activity, self-mutilation, suicidal attempts, alcohol and/or drug use, physical and verbal aggression, and promiscuous behaviors. Many of the young women have had previous unsuccessful residential/community-based interventions, perhaps contributing to a feeling of hopelessness or failure.

DBI provides comprehensive clinical services such as Cognitive Behavior Therapy, Dialectical Behavior Therapy, and Behavior Modifications. DBI provides the following therapy services: Individual/family therapy, clinical group therapy, life skills therapy, sexual aggression and psychiatric services, recreational group therapy and trauma group therapy.

OTHER CONTRACTED PROVIDERS CONSIDERED:

All clinically appropriate providers currently under open contract were considered and none were available or deemed appropriate by the case manager based on the youths' diagnosis and presenting behaviors.
