### McLean Volunteer Fire Department

#### DRAFT

McLean Volunteer Fire Department incorporated in 1923 as Station No 1 in Fairfax County.<sup>1</sup> A two-bay firehouse was built in 1925,<sup>2</sup> followed by a rear addition in 1932.<sup>3</sup> In 1948 a four-bay structure replaced the original station.<sup>4</sup> For several years the firemen and Ladies Auxiliary sponsored the McLean Carnival to raise funds for firefighting necessities.<sup>5</sup> The firehouse also functioned as McLean's community center by providing space for civic meetings and other activities.<sup>6</sup> Station No 1 relocated to Laughlin Avenue in 1988<sup>7</sup> giving the older building to Fairfax County.<sup>8</sup>

In 1990 the McLean Community Center converted the former station into a teen center, "The Old Firehouse."<sup>9</sup>
