Homeless Data Integration Project (HDIP).

- Staff recommends the Fairfax CoC participates in the statewide HDIP.
- Presentation last month, materials sent via email.

- If not, a CoC Board vote is required to approve the Fairfax CoC's participation in HDIP.



Vote: Proposed Revisions to Bylaws

- Some formatting, word usage changes throughout.
- Most changes to Remote Participation policy based on new laws effective July 1, 2024.
- Highlights:
 - Policy must be reviewed, readopted annually.
 - Remote persons with disabilities or caretakers counted for quorum.

CoCBuils: The Basics

- Supports new construction, acquisition, or rehabilitation of permanent supportive housing, as well as supportive services, operating costs, and administration.
- \$175 million nationally, approximately 25 awards.
- Min. award = \$1 million / Max. award = \$10 million.
- Period of Performance = 10/2025 – 10/2030.
- Applications are to be completed by the organization that will administer the funds and must be sent to the CoC's Collaborative Applicant for review and submission.
- Due date = 11/21/2024.



CoCBuils: Application Rating Factors

- Development Experience and Leveraging (24 pts.)
- Managing Homeless Projects (12)
- Implementation Schedule (12)
- Property Maintenance (5)
- Unmet Housing Need (7)
- Management of Rental Housing (10)
- Coordinated Entry (3)
- Coordination with Housing Providers, Healthcare Organizations, and Social Services Providers.
- Experience Promoting Racial Equity.
- Community Integration for Persons with Disabilities.
- Section 3 Requirement (2).
- Policy Initiative Preference Points: Environmental Justice (2).



Information: Reston Temp. Overnight Shelter.

- Opening Monday, July 29.
- Operating 5 pm to 7 pm, every night.
- Prioritized for approximately 40 individuals sleeping in nearby wooded area.
- Encampment will wind down in following weeks.
- Clears path for new Embury Rucker Community Shelter.
