## FY 2020 Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) Program

### Income Limits

The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) annually sets income limits for its programs based on the median income of residents in the Fairfax County metropolitan area.

The chart below outlines the income limits for Fairfax County Redevelopment and Housing Authority's (FCRHA) Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) program. These income limits represent the maximum allowable income that a family can have at initial screening in order to be eligible to receive a FCRHA housing subsidy.

HUD updates these figures annually based on regional changes in income.
