**COMMISSION BUSINESS:**

PDALP LLC DBA Reston Glade, et al.:** It was moved by Commissioner Shumaker and seconded by Commissioner Salinas that this complaint be dismissed due to insufficient evidence that a violation of the Fairfax County Fair Housing Act has occurred consistent with the recommendation of OHREP. The motion passed with majority vote with Commissioner Conde opposing and Commissioner Blake abstaining.

**FIR - HRC #2023067H / HUD #03-23-3897-8 - Arias, Jose v. Southgate Square Cluster Association:** It was moved by Commissioner Salinas and seconded by Commissioner Conde that this complaint be dismissed due to insufficient evidence that a violation of the Fairfax County Fair Housing Act has occurred consistent with the recommendation of OHREP. The motion passed with majority vote with Commissioner Ashby opposing and Commissioner Blake abstaining.

**FIR - HRC #2023050H/ HUD #03-23-3975-8 - Wolfe, John v. Brian and Patricia Breuhaus et al.:** It was moved by Commissioner Shumaker and seconded by Commissioner Conde that this complaint be dismissed due to insufficient evidence that a violation of the Fairfax County Fair Housing Act has occurred consistent with the recommendation of OHREP. The motion passed unanimously.
